User Manual: Collaborative Sessions – Teacher $WGL\ v1.2$

After entering in your area, you can follow these steps and create group(s) for a class, in a collaborative work session (cws).

Step 1: Select Workbench.

• Use the GeoGebra applet to create all the constructions that you want to make available in the cws;

Step 2: Select List of Constructions;

- select the construction and click on Update;
- click on Push to see the construction;
- add text on the Description window, to describe the task/activity;
- click on update the construction.

Step 3: Select Administration;

- Class Management, if needed:
 - \triangle fill in the Class details: name, number of students and educational level;
 - △ fill in the Students details: name, username. You can change the password (randomly generated);
 - \triangle click on finish.
- Students Management
 - \triangle you can Add students, if needed:
 - ♦ select Default Group, if you want the student to be part of a given group;
 - ♦ add student (with the same characteristics of the group class);
 - ♦ click on create_student.
- Groups Management, the classes just created will appear as a group;
 - \triangle you can Add Groups, if needed:
 - ♦ in the empty field type the name of a group;
 - ♦ click Add Group.
- Users to Groups Management used to build the groups of students to work in the cws;
 - \triangle Groups, Users and for each group, the students belonging to that group;
 - \triangle deselect the association between the class group and the users;
 - \triangle associate User(s) to Group(s);
 - \triangle click on Update Membership.
- GeoConstruction to Groups Management used to associate the constructions;
 - $\triangle \ \ associate \ one \ \texttt{GeoConstructions} \ \ to \ \ \texttt{Group}(s);$
 - \triangle click on Update Sharing.
- GeoConstruction Permissions Management;
 - \triangle check the permissions to assign to each GeoConstruction;
 - \triangle click on Update Permissions, if needed.

Step 4: Select Collaborative Work;

- Session Management;
 - \triangle Create Collaborative Work Session;
 - fill in the Name, Task Description and the Task Report (to be changed later, if needed);

- \$ click on create_cw;
- ♦ Change Status to Start. From this point on the students interface change from the normal session to the collaborative work session.
- Groups Management;
 - \triangle associate Collaborative Work sessions with Group(s);
 - \triangle click on Update Sharing.
- Construction Management;
 - \triangle associate Collaborative Work sessions with Constructions;
 - \triangle click on Update Sharing.
- See Students Work to follow the cws;
 - \triangle you can select a given group in order to Show Group Construction;
 - △ you can select a given student, of a given group, in order to Show Student Construction;
 - \triangle you can know which student is the Lock owner;
 - \triangle you can send short messages to students (in the selected group).

Step 5: When finished Collaborative Work;

- \triangle select Session Management;
- \triangle Change Status to Close. From this point on the student's interface change from the collaborative work session to the normal session.
